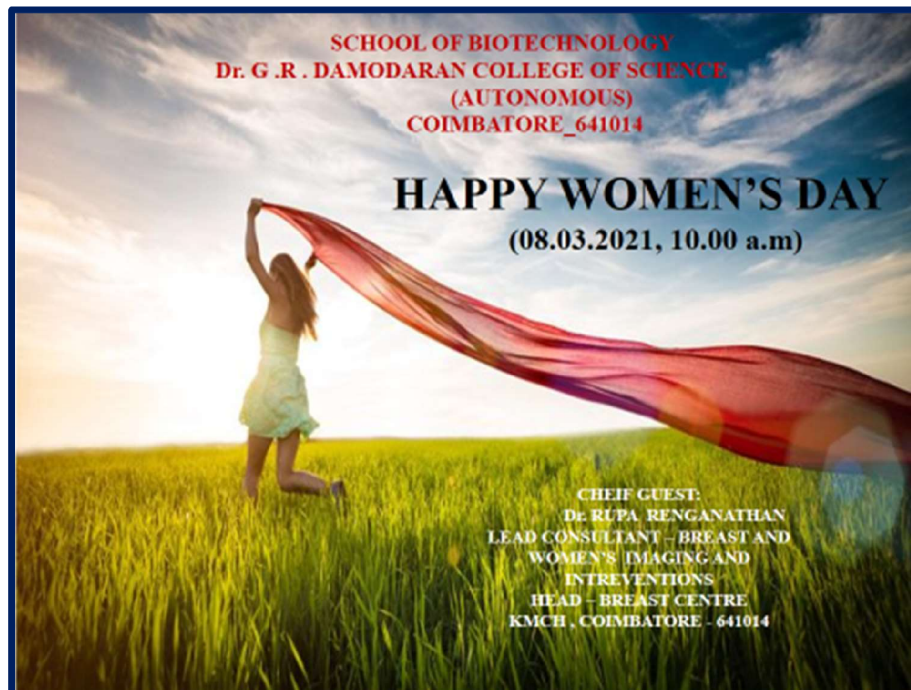

About the Webinar:

Session I

The Resource person started by giving a welcome address to the participants and mentioned about the awareness for World Suicide Prevention Day. Then she began with the topic “Self-Love – You Are Worth It”. She gave a detailed explanation about self-love as a skill and why it is important and how

one can practice self-love. She first explained the concept of self and then helped understand the concept of self-love.

She also detailed the first illustrations of self which included physical, psychological and social exhibits. The Resource person spoke about the second Illustration of Self: - 'I' and 'ME'. She played a small video and discussed it with the participants.

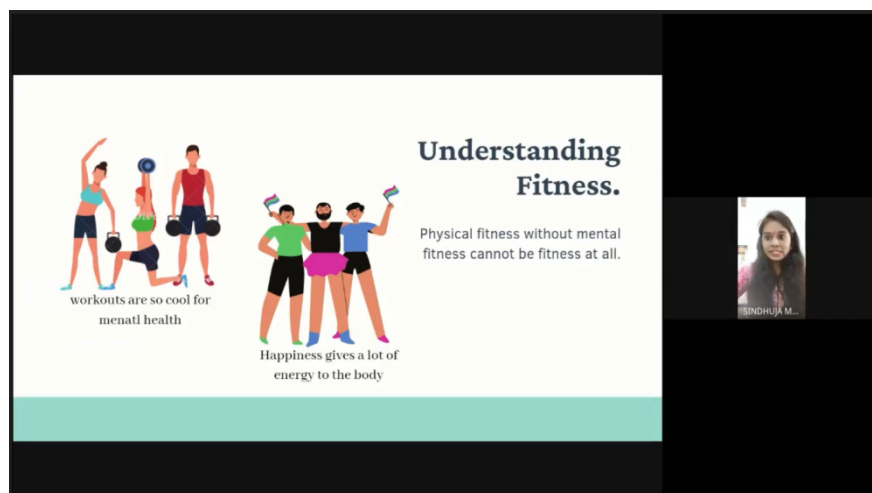

TEACHER'S DAY

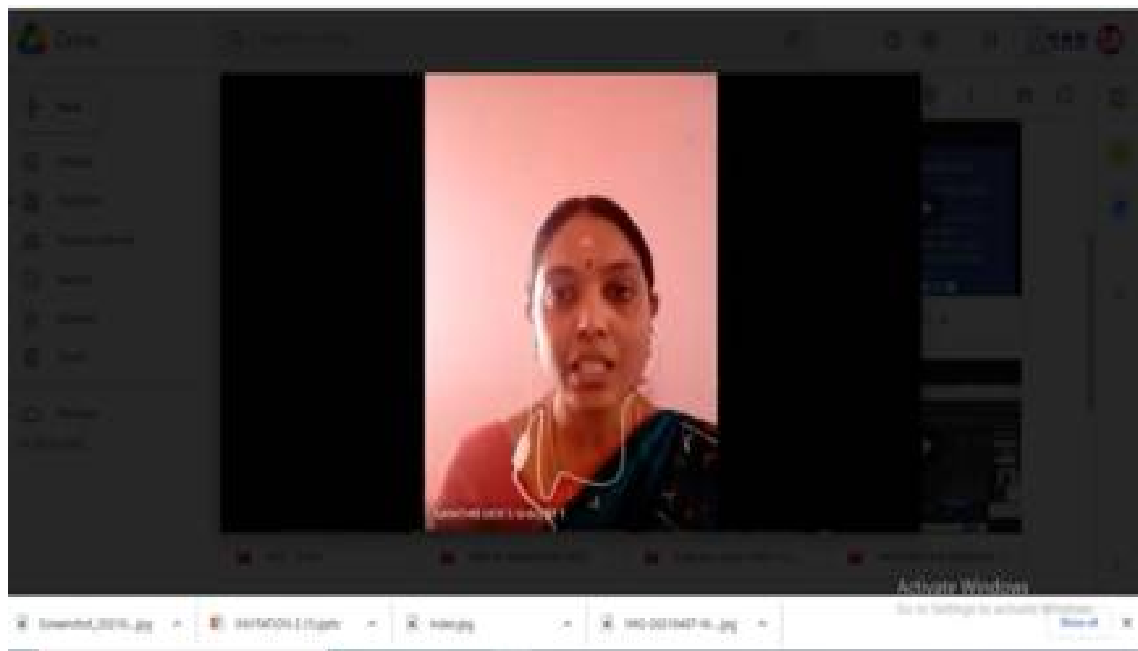

SIMAROUBA GLAUCA

- Simarouba glauca belongs to family Simaroubaceae. Simaroubaceae comprises 32 genera and over 170 species. Commonly known as "The Paradise Tree" or "King Oil Seed Tree" or "Laxmitaru Tree". *S. glauca* is a medium-sized tree that grows up to 20 m high, with a trunk of maximum 80 cm in diameter. The tree produces bright green leaves 20 to 50 cm in length, white flowers, and red fruits.
- The leaves of SG have been used as potential source of anticancer agents in traditional medicine. The anti-cancer potential of SG leaves is just because phytochemicals. The *S. glauca* has promising antioxidant activity. Simarouba glauca extract has been reported for the presence of alkaloids, flavonoids, cardenolides, glycosides, phenolic compounds, saponins and fixed oils.
